

ABOUT FOUNDATIONS HOUSE



Admission Requirements:

- Minimum of 30 days of sobriety required.
- Each resident will undergo a screening interview and drug test prior to admission

Stay Duration:

- We anticipate an average stay of 6-9 months, though residents may stay for up to 2 years, depending on their progress

Program Overview:

- Residents will engage in mandatory and volunteer groups, including:
- Intensive Outpatient Therapy (I.O.T)
- Case Management
- Christian-centered groups
- Our program follows a level system, where residents are encouraged to progress through levels of increasing responsibility and engagement.

Certification:

- Foundations House will be a L3 certified recovery residence by the state of Indiana, ensuring the highest standards of care.

Important Dates:

- We will be accepting residents at the end of January 2025.
- We will notify you when our waitlist opens.
- We anticipate that Foundations House will be at full capacity within 3-4 months after opening.
