

## Residential Program For Men Coming Soon!



Many of our friends and supporters were present at our 2019 Gala when Stability First leaders announced our intention to expand our programming for men. on Friday, May 7th we took a big step toward achieving that goal. We purchased a building that will soon transform into our Foundations House for men! This purchase was made possible because of an estate gift from our long-time supporter and friend, Mary Faucett. We praise God for her vision and generosity, and we thank Him for leading us to this property.

The 3100 square foot building on West Morgan Street in Martinsville also has a large attached garage that we plan to extend to create a large dorm space. It will require extensive renovation to create the dorm, restrooms and showers, a large kitchen and dining area, plus classroom and other common areas. An array of contractors have looked over the building to assure us that it can be converted into the space we envision for our ministry. That same team is now working together to put together a detailed plan. We are also putting together a plan to reach out to our supporters and friends to assist us in providing the financial resources that will be needed to transform the building into ideal living and ministry space. While very preliminary, leaders estimate that an additional \$400,000 will be required to convert the building into ideal living and ministry space. Stability First Executive Director, Rick Miller, is optimistic that the facility will open its doors before the end of 2021.

## The Benefits of Our Centerstone Partnership

It's no secret that our state has a homelessness problem. In 2020 alone, 4,037 people experienced homelessness on any given day of the week in Indiana according to the IHDA Point in Time count. Of those 4,037 homeless people, 26% reported having a substance abuse problem, 34% reported having a serious mental illness, 15% were fleeing from domestic violence, and 18% had a previous felony conviction.

One of the biggest challenges facing us at Stability First is finding a way to allow residents of the Magdalene House to overcome these addictions, insecurities, and traumas. Our in-house DETOUR program works closely with residents on substance abuse recovery goals. But sometimes extra support and an outside perspective is needed.
